How to Nominate

The written nomination should explain how the nominee fits the criteria listed below.

1. Extensive experience in the fishing industry, either in setnetting or drifting. For example, a person who fished during the sailboat days would have extensive experience.
2. Respect for the industry and resource demonstrated by safe, legal fishing practices.
3. Demonstrated respect for the environment.
4. Committed to passing along fishing heritage by teaching fishing skills to a son, daughter, relative, or friend.
5. Competitive fishing balanced by a willingness to help other fishermen needing assistance.
6. Must have fished in the Naknek and/or Kvichak fishing district.
